



Sister City Protocol

The Sister City Agreement between Beşiktaş Municipality in Istanbul, Turkey and Budapest 2nd District in Budapest, Hungary

The regional municipalities of Beşiktaş and Budapest 2nd District, based upon the guidelines set in this declaration, have decided to become sister cities in order to develop and strengthen the fellowship between the two nations and to establish a continuity principle and infrastructure for the development of all kinds of cooperation in the fields of common interest.

Both municipalities will be in cooperation to develop relations in many fields such as historical common values, culture, tourism, sports, health, women's and children's rights, supporting the disadvantaged and raising funds for projects.

Based on this perspective, we believe that this agreement will contribute more to world peace and the development of friendship relations between these two cities by creating a modern living environment, increasing artistic sensitivity and contributing to the formation of conscious individuals.

The cooperation between Beşiktaş Municipality and Budapest 2nd District will be realized through mutual visits of representative delegations and exchange of information on the issues or problems of common interest.
